the High Peak trail you are close to Middleton Top, as you might expect, is at the top of a hill and offers delightful views of the surrounding countryside. This site has a visitor centre, gift shop and [cycle hire centre](#), car park, toilets and picnic area. Whether on foot, horse or bike it is an ideal place to start your visit along the beautiful [High Peak Trail](#). It houses the restored steam engine house built in 1829 by the Butterley Company to haul wagons up the Middleton incline. The Middleton Top Engine House is open to the public on certain weekends throughout the year.

The countryside centre sells a range of books, maps, leaflets and gifts, along with hot and cold drinks, ice creams and snacks.

Bakewell Showground for Easter Weekend

Bakewell is a market town and civil parish in the Derbyshire Dales district of Derbyshire, known for its Bakewell pudding. It lies on the River Wye, 15 miles (23 km) south-west of Sheffield. Bakewell attracts many domestic and foreign tourists. Monday is popular as the town's traditional market day. The cattle market is held in a purpose-built agricultural centre across the river from the town centre, where a stall market is held.

The Bakewell pudding is an English dessert consisting of a flaky pastry base and a layer of sieved jam and topped with a filling made of egg and almond paste.

The race circuit at Darley Moor is situated on a high plateau just outside Ashbourne, Derbyshire. With its characteristic triangular shape, it is based on the runways of a Second World War airfield and benefits from long, fast, straights, sweeping and tricky bends, a chicane and esses.

Opened in 1943 as an RAF training facility Darley Moor remained in military use after the Second World War until 1954, being used for ordnance servicing and storage. Since then, the airfield complex has been used for motorsports, leisure aviation and agriculture.

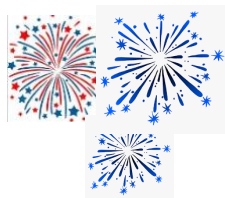
